Diagram 3 - shown at $\mathbf{5 0 \%}$
Repeat with (7) units for right side border.
Use Corner Foundation Piecing template to piece (4) units as shown in Diagram 4.

Sew (1) unit to each end of the left side border. Sew to left side of quilt. Repeat for right side unit. Sew to right side of quilt.

Layer, quilt, bind and enjoy!

## Fabric Requirements

1-3/4 yards 28773-10 Beige
Background - pieced blocks
3/4 yard 28762-1 Ivory and black print
Pieced border
1-1/4 yards 28772-2 Red flag print
Pieced border, binding
1/4 yard each of miscellaneous prints for piecing -
28775-2, 28760-2, 28776-1, 28757-5, 28762-3, 28775-4,
28757-3, 28768-6, 28769-9, 28758-4, 28771-2, 28759-2

## Cutting Directions:

From 28773-10 beige background,
Cut (12) 3-1/8" strips across width of fabric.
Then, cut (140) $3-1 / 8$ " squares for Template A of LeMoyne Star blocks.
Cut (5) 5" strips across width of fabric. Then, cut (35)
$5^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut each square twice diagonally for template B of LeMoyne Star blocks. This will be 140 triangles. IMPORTANT: The triangle is a little large. When stitching to Template C , start at the " Y " seam and allow long edge to extend beyond block. Trim outside edge of block to $9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ X $9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ when pieced.

Use $1 / 4$ yard pieces of fabric to make a total of (35) LeMoyne Star blocks.

Referring to Diagram 1, for each block, cut (1) 2-3/8" strip across width of fabric and use a 45 degree angle on an acrylic
ruler to make first cut and make the second cut $3-3 / 8$ " from the first. Cut (8)
Template C parallelograms for each block.

Note: most of the blocks in the quilt are fussy cut.

## Instructions

Make (35) LeMoyne Star blocks as shown in Diagram 2.

Use (4) 28773-10 beige background squares for
Template A, (4) 28773-10 beige background triangles for Template B and (8) parallelograms of the same fabric for Template C for each block.


Diagram 2
Arrange blocks in (7) rows of five blocks each and sew together.

## Border

Important: Refer to a quilting book for general instructions for foundation piecing.
Use Border Foundation Piecing Template to piece (22) units, as shown in Diagram 3.

Sew (5) units together and stitch to top of quilt.
Repeat for bottom border of quilt.
Repeat with (7) units for left side border.
