

Cutting the Fabric

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances.

All cuts are the width of the fabric unless otherwise indicated.

To minimize stretching of bias edges, heavily starch and iron fabrics before cutting.

Fabric	Quantity	Fabric Number	Placement of Fabric	Cutting Guide
	1 3/4 yards	35185-X Multi	Triangle in 9" squares	Cut 9 7/8" strips. Cut 4 squares from each strip measuring 9 7/8" each for a total of 24 squares. Cut each square diagonally once creating 48 triangles.
	1 3/4 yards	35187-2 White OR 35187-3 Green	Triangle in 9" squares	Cut 9 7/8" strips. Cut 4 squares from each strip measuring 9 7/8" each for a total of 24 squares. Cut each square diagonally once creating 48 triangles.
	1 ¼ yard	33447A-Multi	Diagonally striped border ***Piano Key Border	Cut 3 ½" strips on a 45 degree diagonal. Sew together to make 2 strips 3 ½" x 60 ½" and 2 strips 3 ½" x 78 ½".
	5/8 yard	35186-1 Black	Binding	the width of the fabric. Cut 8 strip 2 ¼ or 2 ½ depending on how wide you make your binding

Additional Material Needed:

- · 4 yards for backing
- 66" x 84" Quilt Batting

Making the Quilt

- 1. Sew each triangle of the multi dot to a black and white triangle creating 48 squares. Press. Check measurements of squares and trim squares to 9 ½".
- 2. Arrange the squares to form the zigzag pattern. Sew together in rows. Press seams in opposite directions. Sew rows together. Press and square up corners as needed.
- 3. Sew side striped strips first then sew on the top and bottom strips.

Finishing the Quilt

- 1. Divide backing into 2 lengths. Join panels lengthwise. Seam will run horizontally.
- 2. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste and quilt as desired.
- 3. Join 2 1/4" or 2 1/2" wide strips into 1 continuous piece for binding. Fold lengthwise and press. Trim and square quilt. Sew binding to quilt with a quarter inch seam. Either hand stitch in place; or turn, press, and machine stitch in the ditch.
