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QUILT SIZE: 48" square

Fabric Requirements:

From Farmhouse West collection by Windham Fabrics:
Fat Quarters of all prints for scrappy blocks, lettering, and corner blocks
in border
Fat Quarter #25807-2 for cowboy boots appliqué
1-1/4 yd. #25802-22 for borders and center block background
3 yds. #25801-14 for backing
1/3 yd. #25800-14 for binding

Center Block:

Cut 12-1/2" square of #25802-22. Trace cowboy boot template, one boot and one reversed, onto a lightweight fusible appliqué web, following manufacturer's instructions. Stitch around the appliqué with a small zig zag stitch, using invisible polyester thread.

Square in a Square Blocks:

For *each* block, cut:

- (1) 3-1/2" square for center
 - (1) 4-1/4" square, cut twice on the diagonal, for first round of triangles
 - (2) 4" squares, cut once on the diagonal, for outer round of triangles
- Make 32 blocks 6-1/2" each

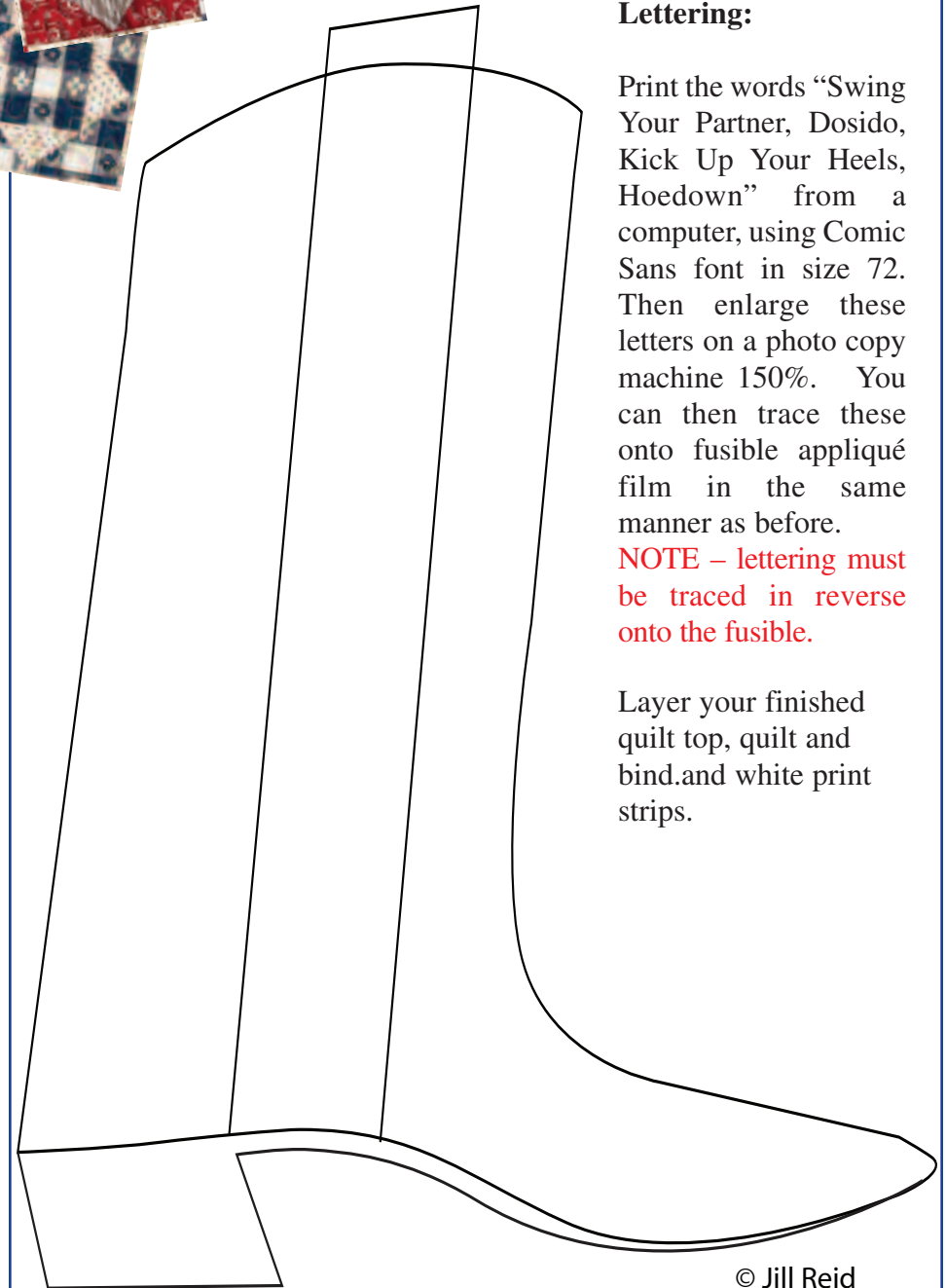
Borders:

Cut:

- (4) 6 -1/2" x 36 1/2" strips of #25802-22
- (4) 6 -1/2" corner squares of # 25811-14



Boot pattern



Assemble blocks in rows and add borders.

Lettering:

Print the words "Swing Your Partner, Dosido, Kick Up Your Heels, Hoedown" from a computer, using Comic Sans font in size 72. Then enlarge these letters on a photo copy machine 150%. You can then trace these onto fusible appliqué film in the same manner as before.

NOTE – lettering must be traced in reverse onto the fusible.

Layer your finished quilt top, quilt and bind, and white print strips.
