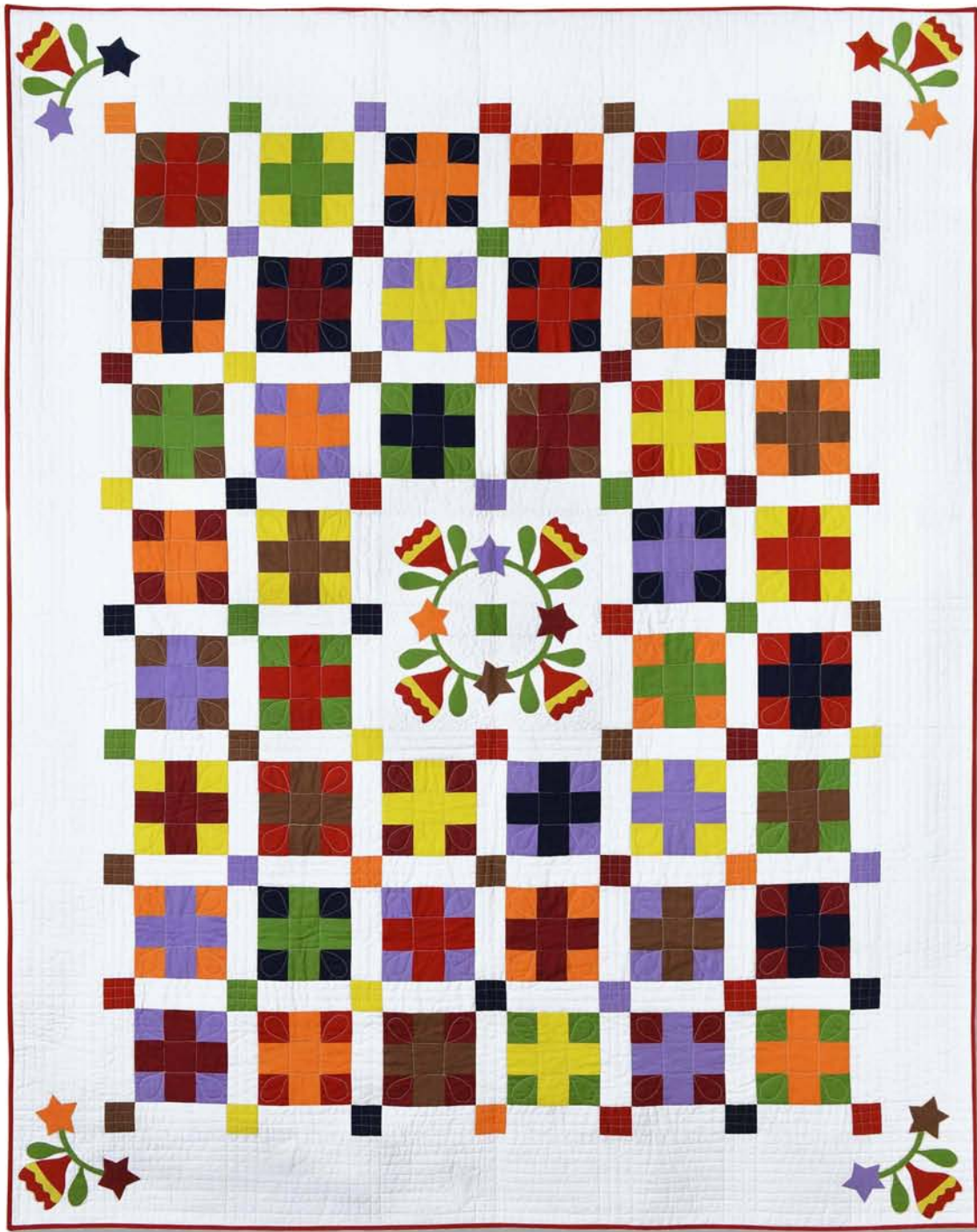

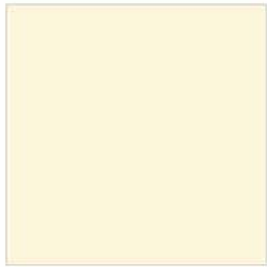

## Materials required:

3/8 yard: purple, indigo, madder red, brown, chrome yellow, cheddar, poison green

1 yard: turkey red \*includes cross-grain binding

3 yards: ivory

Backing: 2-1/2 yards 108" wide quilt backing 32679-1 or 5 yards 45" wide fabric.

## Cut:

Ivory: note: Cut border strips **A** and **B** first.

**A:** (2) 6-1/2" x 62-1/2"

**B:** (2) 6-1/2" x 66-1/2"

**C:** (2) 6-1/2" x 14-1/2"

**D:** (108) 6-1/2" x 2-1/2"

**Note:** Cut appliqué pieces for center and border before cutting for blocks.

## For Blocks:

**E:** 6-1/2" x 2-1/2"

(6) purple, turkey red, brown, chrome yellow

(5) indigo, madder red, cheddar, poison green

**F:** 2-1/2" squares

(36) turkey red, cheddar, brown, purple

(30) poison green, chrome yellow, madder red, indigo

## For Sashing Corner Squares:

**G:** 2-1/2" squares

(63) mix of all colors except ivory

# "Star Weaver"

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## Center Block:

Sew a **D** to one side of a poison green **G**. Repeat on the opposite side to form a 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" strip. Press.

Sew a **C** to top of the strip. Repeat on the bottom to form a 14-1/2" block, unfinished. Enlarge appliqué pattern 200%.

Appliqué in favorite method.

**Note:** *There is no seam allowance in the pattern. Add as needed for method used. Use quilt photo as a color guide. The dotted line square can be used to help center the appliqué design.*

## For Each Block:

Choose two colors:

**E:** (1) color 1

**F:** (2) color 1

**F:** (4) color 2

Sew together (3) **F** squares as follows: color 2, color 1, color 2. Repeat to form a second strip. Attach a strip to **E**. Repeat on the opposite side to form a 6-1/2" block, unfinished. Make (44) blocks, mixing the color combinations.

## Quilt Top Assembly:

Lay out blocks with **D** as sashing and **G** as corner squares for the sashing with the appliqué block in the center. Use the quilt photo as a guide.

Assemble in rows, attaching the left and right center sections of the quilt top to the center appliqué block first. Then attach the top and bottom sections.

## Borders:

Attach a **B** to the left side of the quilt. Repeat on the right side. Attach an **A** to the top of the quilt. Repeat for the bottom.

## Corner Appliqué:

Use a star-to-star section of the center appliqué pattern for each of the four corners. The dotted line square can be used to help center the appliqué design.

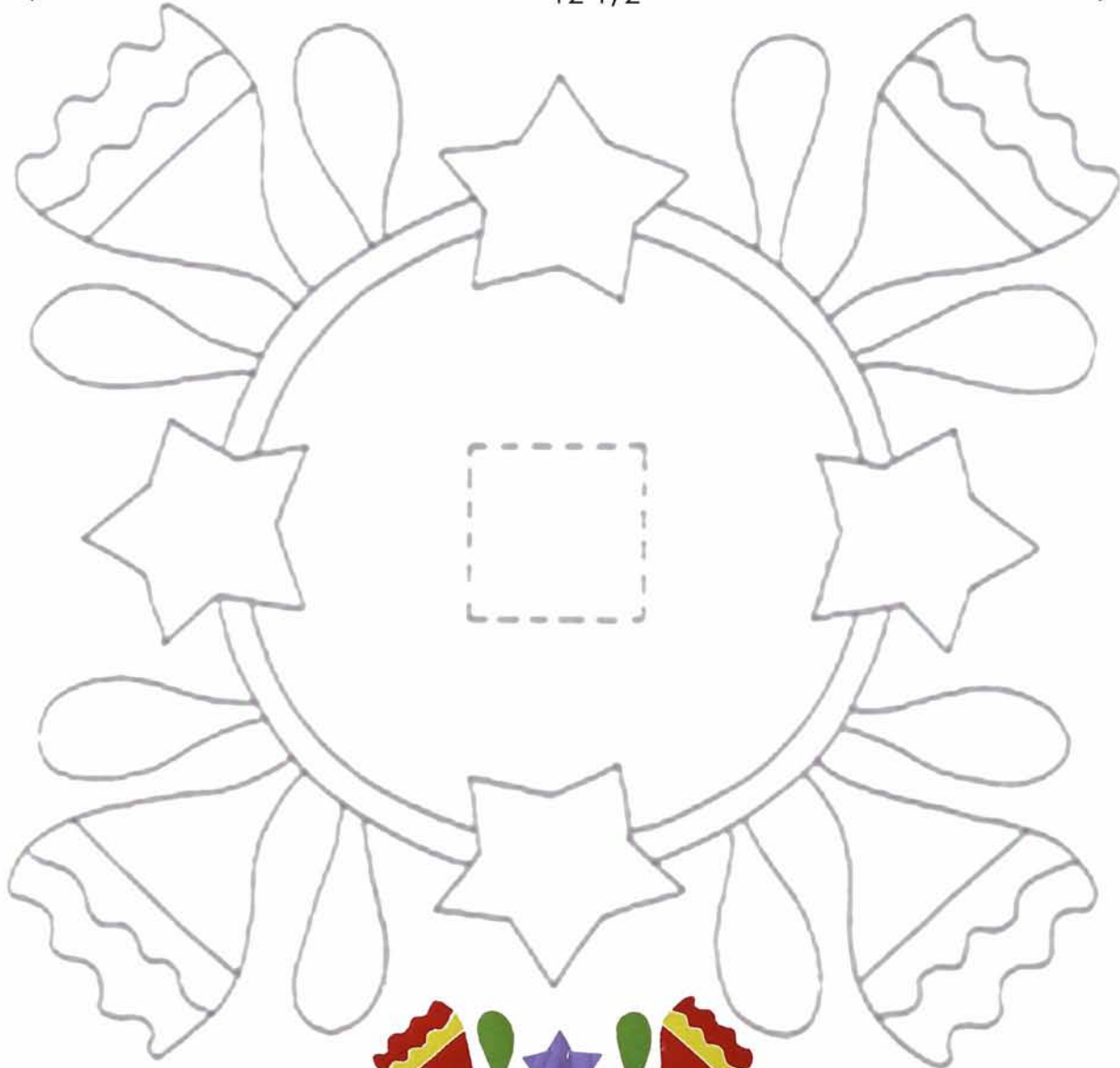
