

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Fabric Requirements:

Cover A

5/8 yard 39024-X Multi or 39022-2 White 1 small amount of 39019-X to get the award placket of choice Bonding agent like Misty Fuse®

Cover B

(1) Fat Quarter each 39021-3 Red, 39023-1 Black, 39023-2 White 1/4 yd lightweight Fusible Interlining 1/4 yd Heavy Weight Fusible Pellon

Cutting & Assembly

Note: All seams are 1/4" wide

COVER A - Bookcover

- Cover a favorite book or notebook with this simple cover. 5/8 yard will make 2 covers. Take the 5/8 yard of fabric and fold in half matching selvages. Cut on fold line to make 2 equal size pieces. Measure the height of the notebook (ours is 9 5/8") take that number x 2 plus 3/4" = 20" (3/4" is to allow for width of notebook & seam allowance). With right sides together, fold in half and sew.
- 2. Press seam allowance open, turn and center the seam. Picture 1

- 3. On each end, turn a 1/4" seam allowance towards wrong side then fold another 1/4" allowance. Press and topstitch. Picture 2
- 4. Take the cover and place over the book by sliding each end of your book into the end of the fabric cover.
- 5. To personalize the cover for a teacher, cut one of the award plackets from 39019-X Multi. With a bonding agent cut to size, put onto the cover center from side to side. Pin in place and remove cover from the book. Following the manufacturer's recommended instructions for youe bonding agent, bond the award placket to the cover and applique using your favorite method.
- 6. Slide the cover back onto the book and you are ready to give it to your favorite teacher. Picture 3

COVER B - Ipad Cover Finished size 8 1/2" x 10"

Cutting and Assembly:

39023-2 White - cut (1) strip 17" x 3 1/4" for top portion
39021-3 Red - cut (1) strip 17" x 1 1/2" for center stripe and
cut (2) strips 8 3/4" x 10 1/2" (for lining)
39023-1 Black - cut (1) strip 17" x 6 3/4" for bottom portion
Heavy Weight Fusible Pellon – Cut (1) piece 17" x 10 1/2"
Light Weight Fusible Interlining – Cut (2) pieces 17" x 10 1/2"
and cut (1) piece 4" x 15"
1/2" inch elastic – Cut 4 pieces 3 3/4" long

Outside

- 1. Take the 3 strips for the outside of the cover and sew together starting with the top portion to the center stripe, then the bottom portion to the center portion. Picture 1
- 2. Press flat with seams open and edge stitch each side of the red center stripe.


3. Fuse lightweight interlining to wrong side of the cover using manufacturer's recommended instructions. Set aside.



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Lining

- 1. Place 1 piece of elastic in top left corner of one piece of the 39021-3 Red lining 2" from the corner in both directions. Pin and stitch 1/8" from the edge. Stitch back and forth several times to reinforce. Picture 2
- 2. Repeat for the other 3 corners. You have just completed the right case lining. Picture 3



3. Join left and right sides together and press seam open. Fuse lightweight interlining to wrong side. Picture 3

Finishing

- 4. Fuse Heavy Weight Pellon to lining following manufacturer's recommended instructions.
- 5. With right sides together place outside of case on top of the lining. Stitch all around leaving a small 3" opening at the bottom so you can turn case to right side.
- 6. Trim corners and carefully trim seam allowance close to the seam on Pellon to reduce bulk when turning. Turn the case to the right side; make sure corners are as square as possible.
- 7. Press flat. Slip stitch opening at bottom closed. Machine stitch 1/8" on all edges. Add a topstitch from top to bottom of the case following the center lining seam. This will help the case to fold more easily. Insert your ipad and you are ready to go!
