Fabric Requirements:

Block centers (33565-1 & 33566-2) - 3/4 yd each

Sashing Center (33570-1) - 3/4 yd

Sashing Light (33567-1) - 1 1/8 yds

Sashing Grey 1 (33568-3) - 5/8 yd

Grey 2 (33569-3) - 5/8 yd

Corner Stars Dark (33567-2) - 3/8 yd

Corner Stars Light (33568-1) - 5/8 yd

Inner Border (33566-3) - 1/2 yd

Outer border (33570-2) - 1 1/4 yds

Binding (33571-2) - 2/3 yd

Backing - 5 yds



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"The Air up There"

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Cutting and Assembly Instructions:

From each of the Block Center fabrics, cut 6 – 12 ½" squares. Set aside until quilt construction.

From Sashing Center fabric, cut:

11 – 2" strips; sub-cut into 31 – 2" x 12 ½" rectangles

From Sashing Light fabric, cut:

15 – 2 ⅜" strips; sub-cut into 248 – 2 ⅜" squares for flying geese.

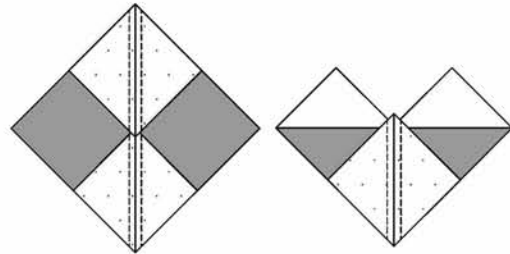
From **EACH** Sashing Grey fabric, cut:

4 – 4 ¼" strips; sub-cut into 31 – 4 ¼" squares for flying geese.

From Grey squares and Light squares, make flying geese blocks. Draw diagonal lines on the wrong sides of all the light squares. Lay, right sides together, two light squares on opposite corners of each grey square. Sew ¼" on both sides of the drawn lines.

Cut on drawn line and press light triangles out.

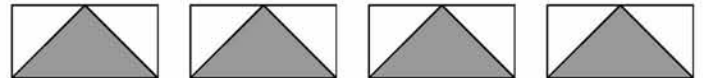
Sew an additional light square on each of these units, right sides together, with the line going opposite of the previous stitching line.



Cut apart and press triangles out. Geese should measure 2" x 3 ½". Trim if necessary. Make 124 geese from each grey.

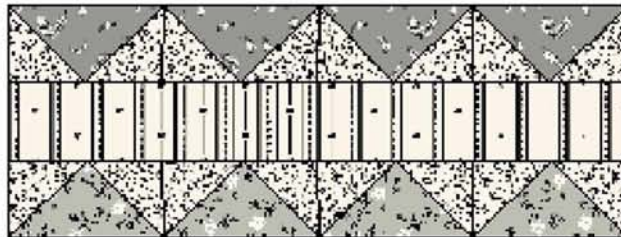
Sew side to side into groups of 4 geese of the same grey.

Press seams open.



Make 31 Sashing units, sewing 1 set of each grey geese to either side of a Sashing Center rectangle.

Press toward center.



From Corner Star Light, cut:

3 – 2 ⅜" strips; sub-cut into 48 – 2 ⅜" squares for Half Square Triangles.

5 – 2" strips; sub-cut into 96 – 2" squares for block corners.

From Corner Star Dark, cut:

3 – 2 ⅜" strips; sub-cut into 48 – 2 ⅜" squares for Half Square Triangles.

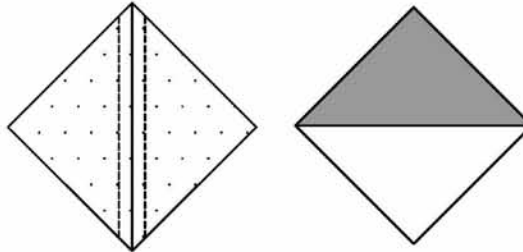
2 – 2" strips; sub-cut into 24 – 2" squares for block centers.



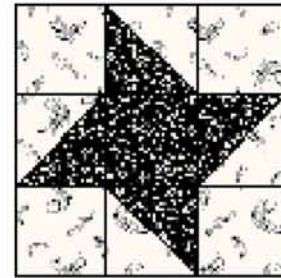

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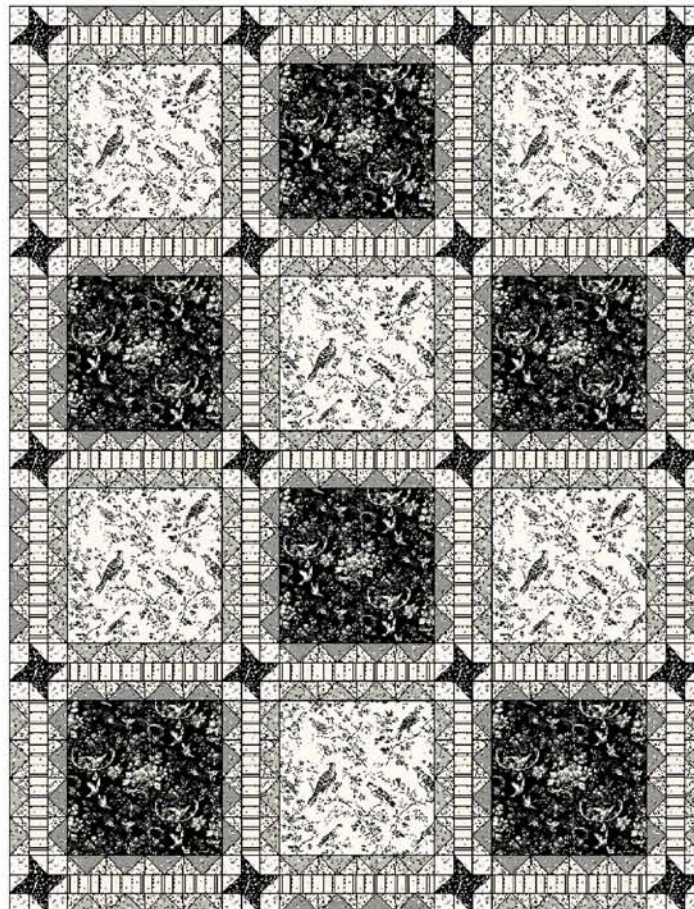
Make Half Square Triangles using the $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the light squares. Pair, right sides together, with a dark square and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on line and press toward dark triangle.



Arrange parts to make 24 Corner Stars. Press toward the solid squares. Blocks should measure 5" unfinished.



To construct quilt center, arrange block centers, sashing units and corner stars so that each block center is framed by the same grey geese. The geese will pair consistently with either the light or dark block center.



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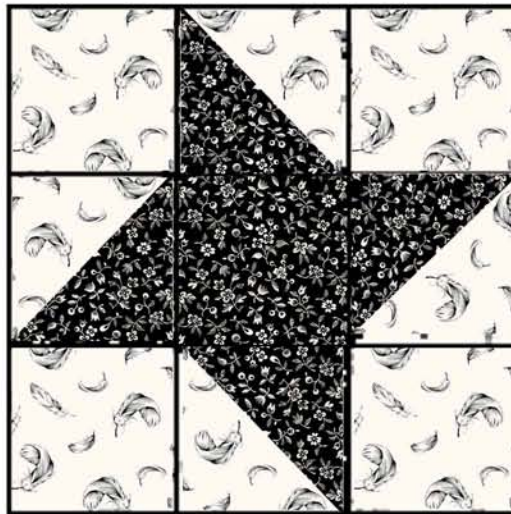

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From Inner Border fabric, cut 7 – 2” strips. Piece together strips into one long strip. Measure long sides of quilt and cut 2 strips to this length. Sew to sides of quilt center. Measure top and bottom sides. Cut and sew inner border strips to these sides.

From Outer Border fabric, cut 7 – 5” strips. Piece together strips, matching stripes as best you can. Measure sides and top and bottom. Cut strips to appropriate lengths and attach, using remaining 4 Corner Stars as corners.

Quilt, bind and enjoy!



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
