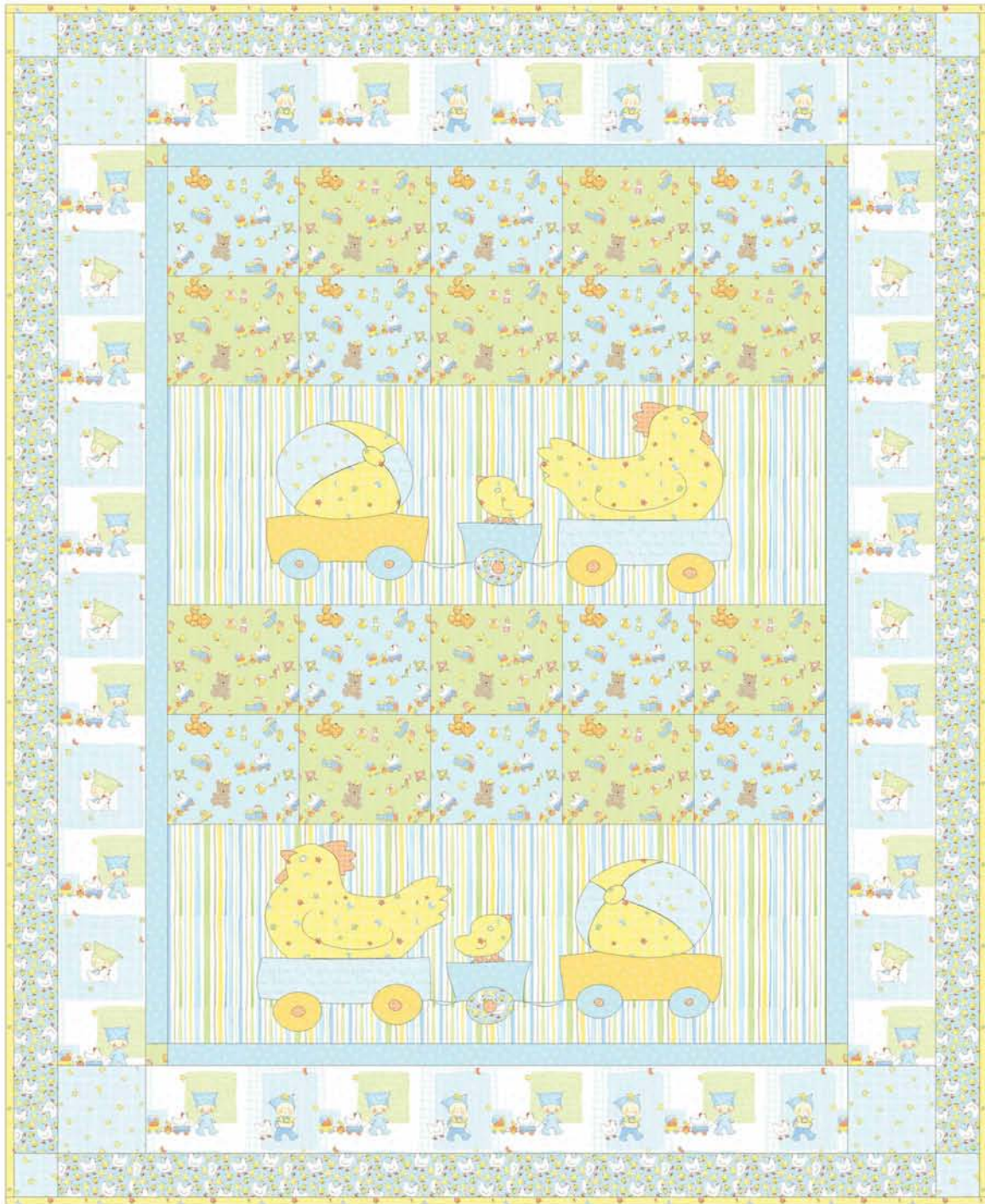





	1 ½ yards	32593-1	Border	Cut 4 – 4 ½" strips WOF Make 2 – 4 ½" x 42 ½" Make 2 – 4 ½" x 32 ½"
	½ yard	32594-3	Checked Center Corner blocks on small border	Cut 2 – 5 ½" Strips Then cut 10 – 8 ½" x 5 ½" rectangles Cut 4 - 1 ½" squares
	½ yard	32594-1	Checked Center	Cut 2 – 5 ½" Strips Then cut 10 – 8 ½" x 5 ½" rectangles
	5/8 yard	32595-1	Background for center of quilt	2 – 10 ½" x 30 ½"
	5/8 yard	32596-1	Border Appliqué: 2 wheels for chick cart	Cut 5 strips WOF 2 ½" Make 2 – 2 ½" x 40 ½" Make 2 – 2 ½" x 50 ½" Appliqué: Two mirror images of each piece. One for each design. Template piece: M
	¼ yard	32597-1	Corner blocks in borders Appliqué: Ball piece	Cut 4 – 4 ½" squares Cut 4 – 2 ½" squares Two mirror images of each piece Template piece: C



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	5/8 yard	32597-4	Binding Appliqué: 2 hens, 2 chicks, 4 ball parts	Cut 5 – 2 ¼” strips WOF Two mirror images of each piece Template pieces: Q, U, B, D
	1/8 yard	32598-1	Appliqué 2 hen carts, 2 ball parts, rope between carts	Two mirror images of each piece Template pieces: E, P, K, O
	3/8 yard	32599-1	Small inner border Appliqué 2 chick carts, 4 wheels, eyes for hen and chick. (You can do thread eyes instead of appliquéing.)	Cut 4 – 1 ½” strips WOF Make 2 – 1 ½” x 40 ½” Make 2 – 1 ½” x 30 ½” Two mirror images of each piece Template pieces: L, G, H, W, Z
	1/8 yard	32599-4	Appliqué 2 ball carts, 4 wheels	Two mirror images of each piece Template pieces: F, A1, C1
	1/8 yard	25028 1930’s solids	Appliqué 10 wheel centers, 2 chick beaks and 4 feet, 2 hen beaks, combs and wattles. Template A can be either blue or peach	Two mirror images of each piece Template pieces: A, I, J, N, B1, D1, S, R, T, V, X, Y

Additional Material Needed:

- 3 yards of fabric for backing
- 50” x 60” Quilt Batting
- Appliqué method requirements. If you are going to fuse design you will need 1 yard of Fusible Webbing.
- If you fuse your design you will need stabilizer for thread work on Appliqué.

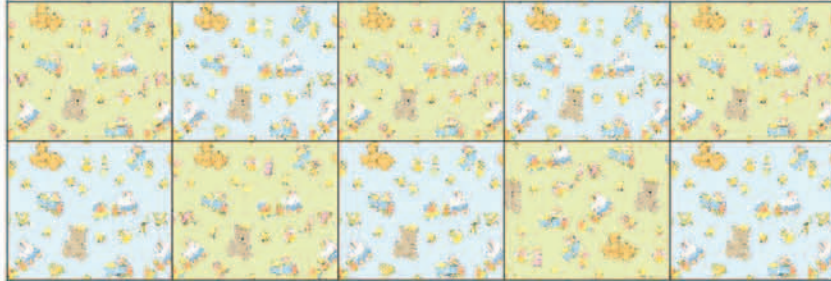


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Assembling the Top:

1. Sew green and blue blocks together as shown. Make two sets.



2. Two appliqué sections

Appliqué pieces to background fabric with your favorite appliqué method or try a new method. These pieces can be hand appliquéed, machine stitched, or fused. Depending on the method you use the templates can be made from freezer paper, template plastic or dryer sheets.

After completing the design, it is time to add the thread work. Put the stabilizer under the background piece before starting. Suggestions: Blanket stitch around each piece. Zigzag around each piece. I would use thread that matched the background of each different fabric.



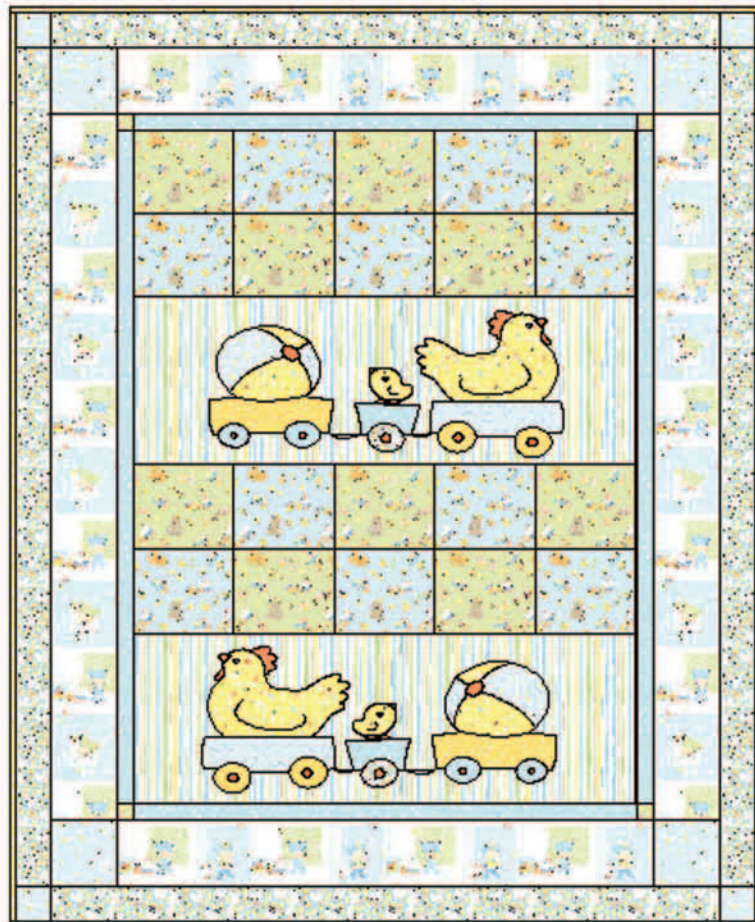
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3. Sew appliquéd sections to checkerboard sections.

Borders

1. Sew longer border pieces to sides of center section first. Add squares to both ends of shorter border pieces. Then sew to top and bottom of quilt matching corner block seams. Press seams outward.
2. Follow the same procedures for all three borders.

Borders

The top is finished! Give it a good pressing. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing. Have fun quilting using circles and star motifs and other creative designs. Trim and add binding. Make sure you add a label for that special person.

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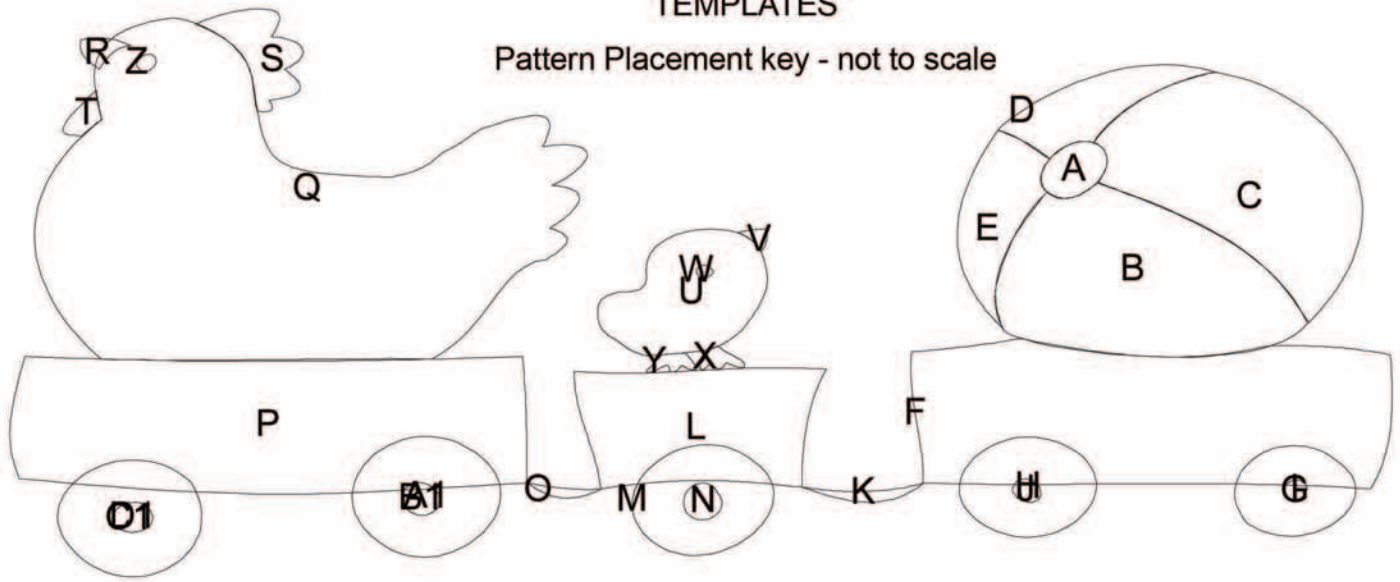
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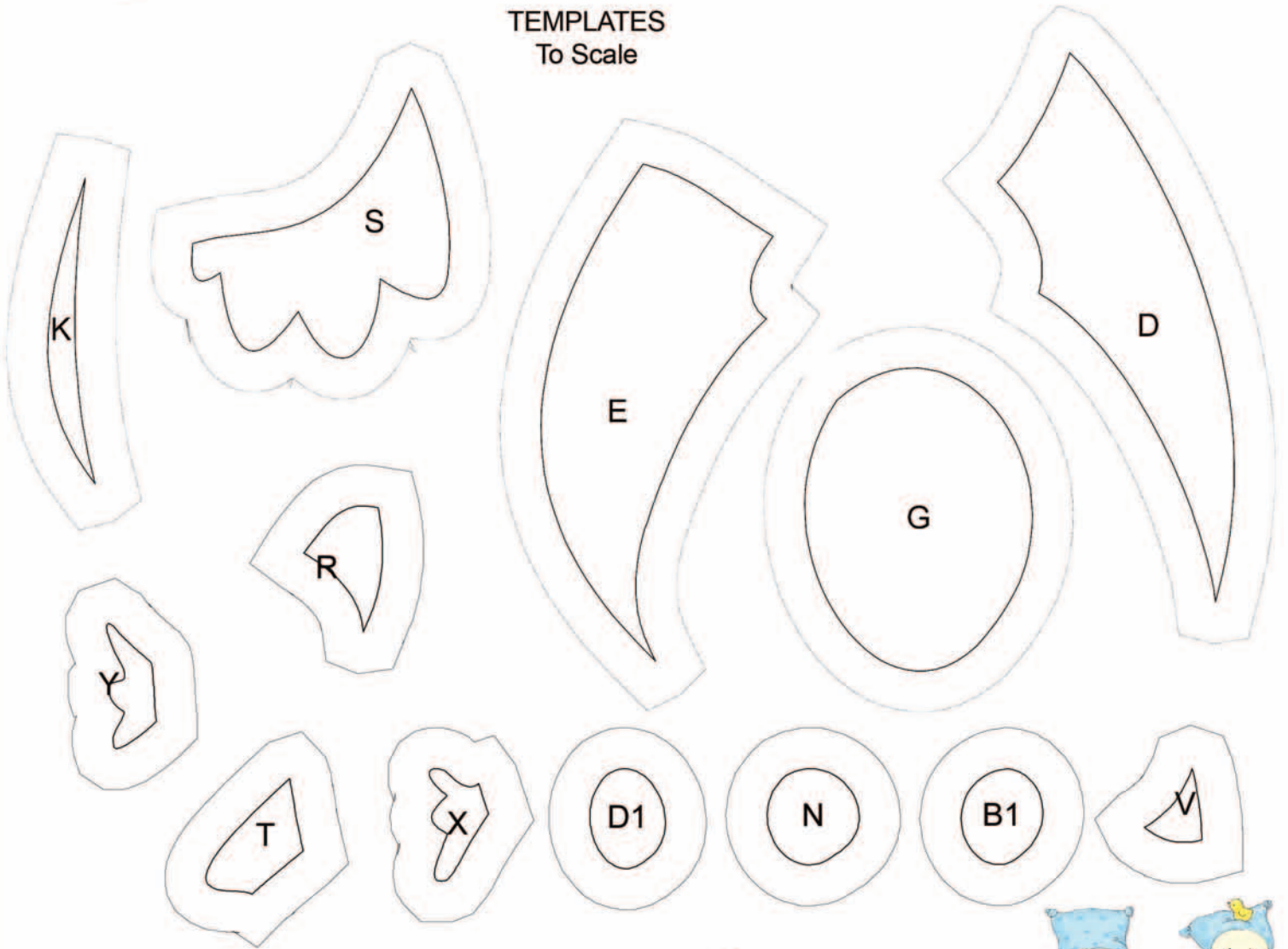

Pattern Placement key - not to scale

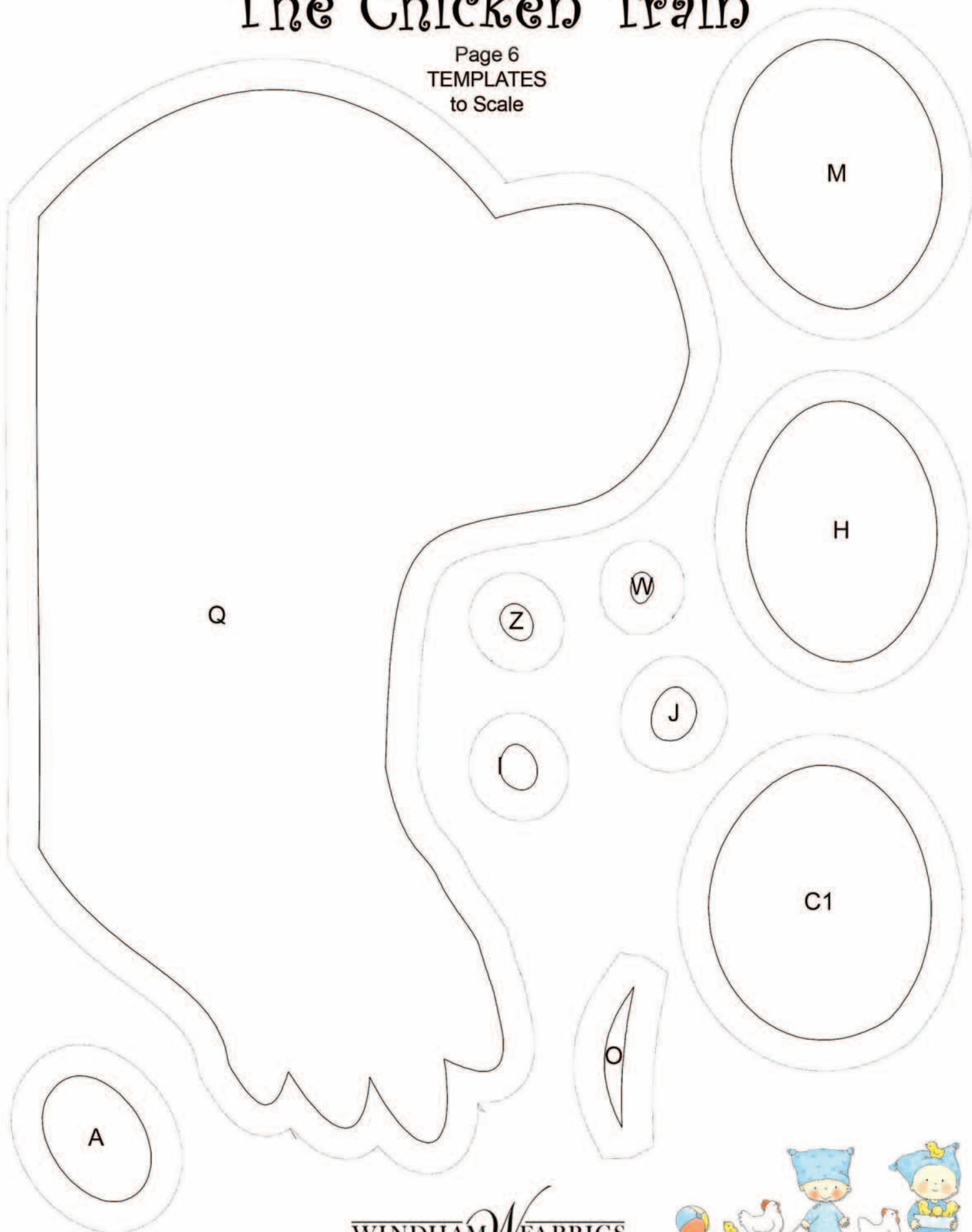
