Fabric Picture	Quantity	Fabric Number	Placement of Fabric	Cutting
	3/8 yard	33342-1	Corner Block B triangle pieces	Cut 2 squares 13 1/4" Cut diagonally 2 times.
	3/8 yard	33342-2	Corner Block B triangle pieces	Cut 1 square 13 1/4" Cut diagonally 2 times.
	1 1/8 yards	33341-X	Center block Inside border	1 – 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" squares 4 – 6" x 39 1/2" strips
	1 yard	30069-3	Three narrow borders	Cut 16 – 2" strips








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	1 ½ yards	33346-6	Outside border	Cut 8 – 6” strips then sew together to make 4 - 6” x 67 ½”
	3/8 yard	33343-1	Block A rectangles	Cut 3 strips 4 ½” then make 8 – 4 ½” x 12 ½”
	1 ½ yards	33344-3	Middle border Center of Block A Arrow in Block B	To make the highway cut strips lengthwise : 4 – 6” x 53 ½” Cut LOF 4 – 4 ½” x 12 ½” Fussy cut 4 triangles so the road goes the right way. Use one of the triangles from the Block B as cutting guide.
	½ yard	33343-2	Corner squares in borders	12 – 6” squares
	5/8 yard	33343-3	Binding	8 – 2 ¼” or 2 ½” depending on the size you like your binding

Additional Material Needed:

- 5 yards for backing
- 86” x 86” Quilt Batting

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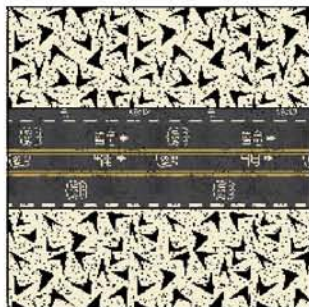


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Assembling the Quilt Top

1. Sew two white rectangles to one highway fabric rectangle as shown. Make 4 blocks. Press.

Block A



2. To create corner blocks sew two cream triangles, one red and one gray as shown. Notice which way the words and highway sign arrows are going. Pressing seams open will give you a flatter center. This is Block B.

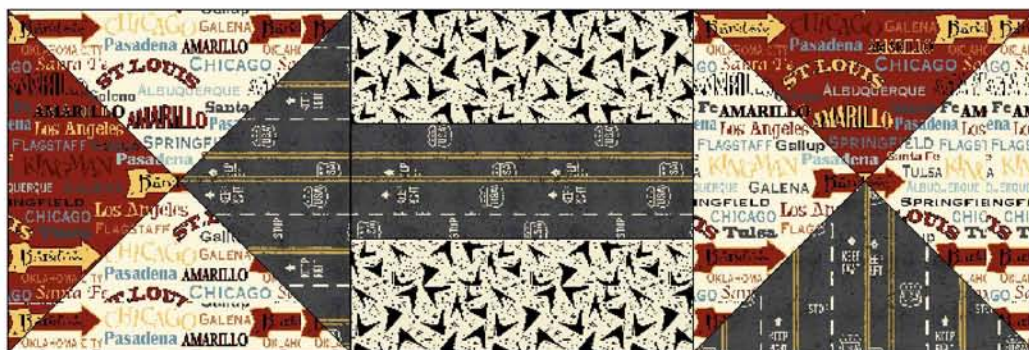

3. Sew top corner Block B to Block A as shown. Make sure the arrows on the highway fabric are pointing to the arrow head triangle.



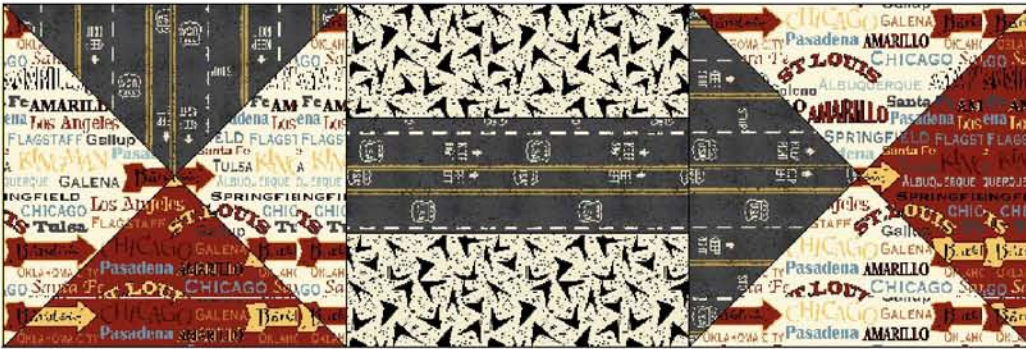
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4. Sew two Block As to Center Square as shown. Make sure the arrows on the highway fabric are pointing to the arrow head triangle.



5. Sew the bottom corner Block B to Block A as shown. Make sure the arrows on the highway fabric are pointing to the arrow head triangle.



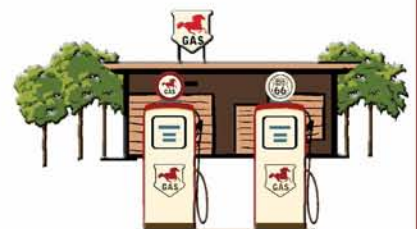
Adding Borders

1. Add gold strips to sides of center section. Press. Trim even.
2. Add gold strip to top and bottom of center section. Press. Trim even.
3. Add two postcard fabric border pieces to sides. Add red squares to the ends of the two other border pieces. Sew these strips to the top and bottom, matching seams.
4. Add the next gold fabric strips in the same fashion as the first gold strips. You will need to piece these to get long enough strips.
5. Add two highway fabric border pieces to sides. Sew red squares to the ends of the two other border pieces. Sew these strips to the top and bottom, matching seams.
6. Add the next gold fabric strips in the same fashion as the first gold strips. You will need to piece these to get long enough strips.
7. Add two blue print fabric border pieces to sides. Sew red squares to the ends of the two other border pieces. Sew these strips to the top and bottom, matching seams. Give your quilt top a good pressing.

Completing the Quilt

1. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing.
2. Quilt as desired and bind.
