## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

### For the Bumper:

1-1/4 yds of 24356-1  
1-1/4 yds of 24357-1 for reverse side  
1-3/8 yds **24355-1** (Piping and Ties)

### Sheet

1-7/8 yds of 24356-1

### Dust Ruffle

2-3/4 yds of 24353-1  
1-3/8 yds of 24357-1 for bands  
Optional: 1-1/4 yds of your choice for bias trim

### Quilt

1-1/8 yds of 24356-1  
1-1/8 yds of 24359-3 for Bands  
1-1/2 yds of 24356-2 for Squares and Back  
1 yd of 24354-1 for Squares and Binding

## FLANNEL RECEIVING BLANKET

Fabrics: 1-1/4 yd flannel - back  
1 yd. coordinating - center

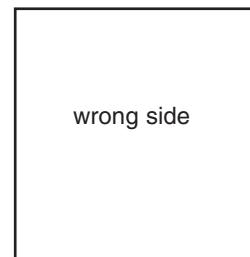
Wash and dry both pieces of flannel two times. Use “warm” water for the wash cycle and “warm” dryer setting.

Square up both pieces of flannel.

Smaller piece will be approximately 35/36"

Larger piece will be approximately 42/43"

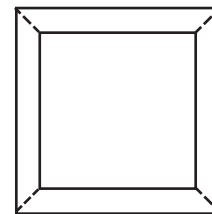
Turn under and press 1/2" along all 4 sides of the larger piece.



1/2" folded over to wrong side

Center the smaller piece of flannel right side up on the above square, wrong sides together.

You will have approximately 3-1/2" – 4" border around your blanket. The larger square is folded to the front to “frame” the smaller square. Miter corners.



Secure the borders with two (2) rows of zigzag, serpentine or straight stitching.
