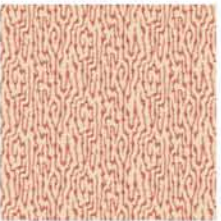

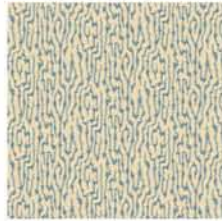

4 – 5 1/2" squares - 33391-1 / red

4 – 5 1/2" squares - 33391-5 / gold

4 – 5 1/2" squares - 33391-6 / green

Stars

Centers:

3 – 5 1/2" squares - 33387-1 / red

2 – 5 1/2" squares - 33387-3 / olive

1 – 5 1/2" squares - 33387-4 / cream

Star Points:

24 – 3" squares - 33386-2 / blue

8 – 3" squares - 33386-3 / olive

16 – 3" squares - 33386-1 / red

Background:

12 – 3 x 5 1/2" rectangles - 33390-1 / red

12 – 3" squares - 33390-1 / red

12 – 3 x 5 1/2" rectangles - 33390-2 / blue

12 – 3" squares - 33390-2 / blue

12 – 3 x 5 1/2" rectangles - 33390-5 / gold

Hexagon Flowers

Background:

4 – 5 1/2" squares - 33389-1 / red

3 – 5 1/2" squares - 33389-2 / blue

2 – 5 1/2" squares - 33389-5 / gold

Hexagons (cut from scraps)

54 – 2 1/2" squares - assorted fabrics

9 – 2 1/2" squares - assorted fabrics

Vine Blocks

Backgrounds: 12 – 5 1/2" squares - assorted fabrics

Vines

Each Block: 7" of 1/4" finished bias - 33388-3 / olive

Each Medallion: 36" of 1/4" finished bias - 33388-3 / olive

Leaves

Vines: 35 – 3 x 2" rectangles 17 - 33386-3 / olive

18 - 33391-6 / green

Medallion Leaves: 27 each medallion

78 – 3 x 2" rectangles - 33390-5 / gold

Borders

Inner Border:

2 – 1 1/2 x 45 1/2" sides - 33386-3 / green

2 – 1 1/2 x 47 1/2" top/bottom - 33386-3 / green

Outer Border:

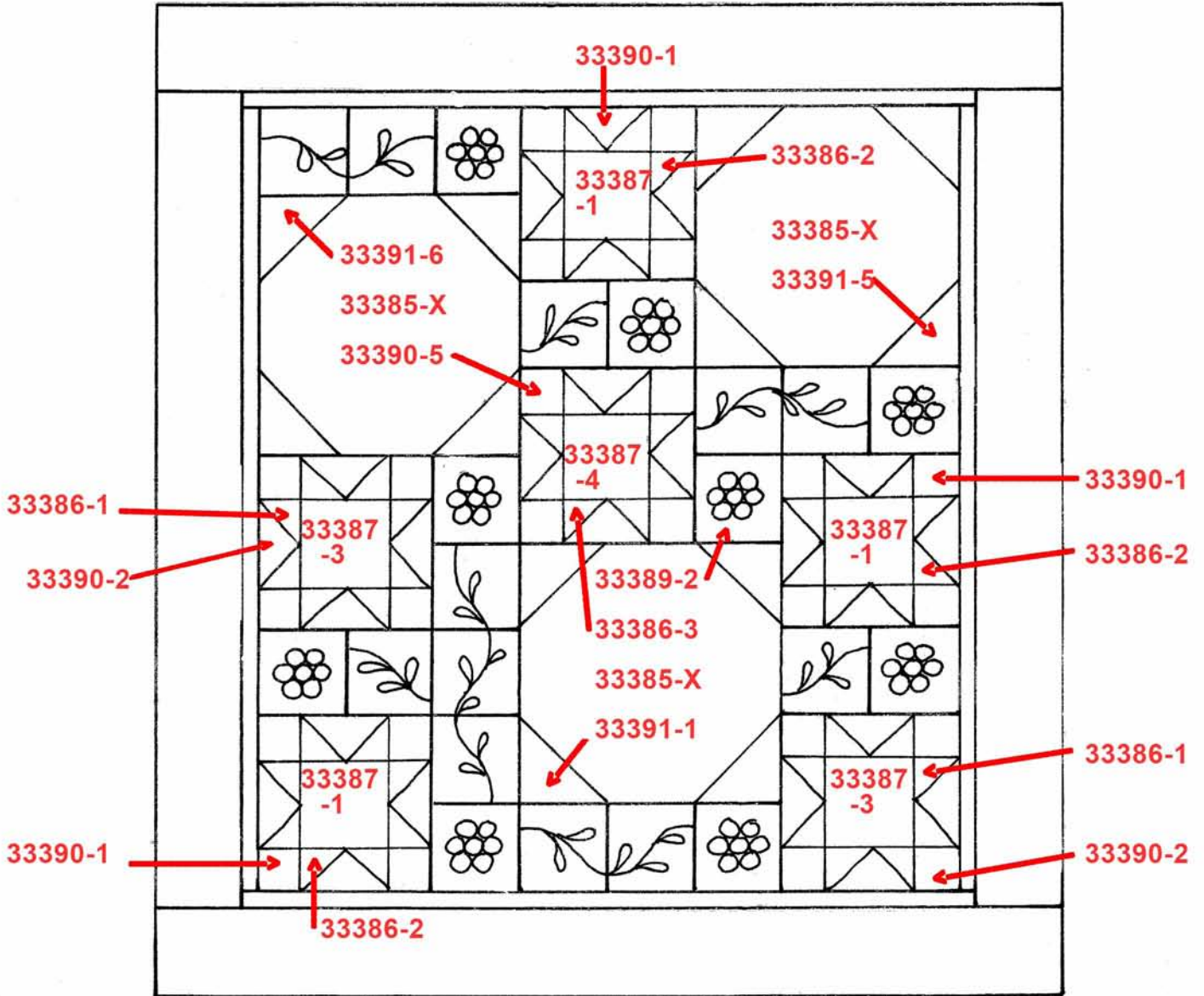
2 – 5 1/2 x 47 1/2" sides - 33385-x

2 – 5 1/2 x 57 1/2" top/bottom - 33385-x

Fabric Designations



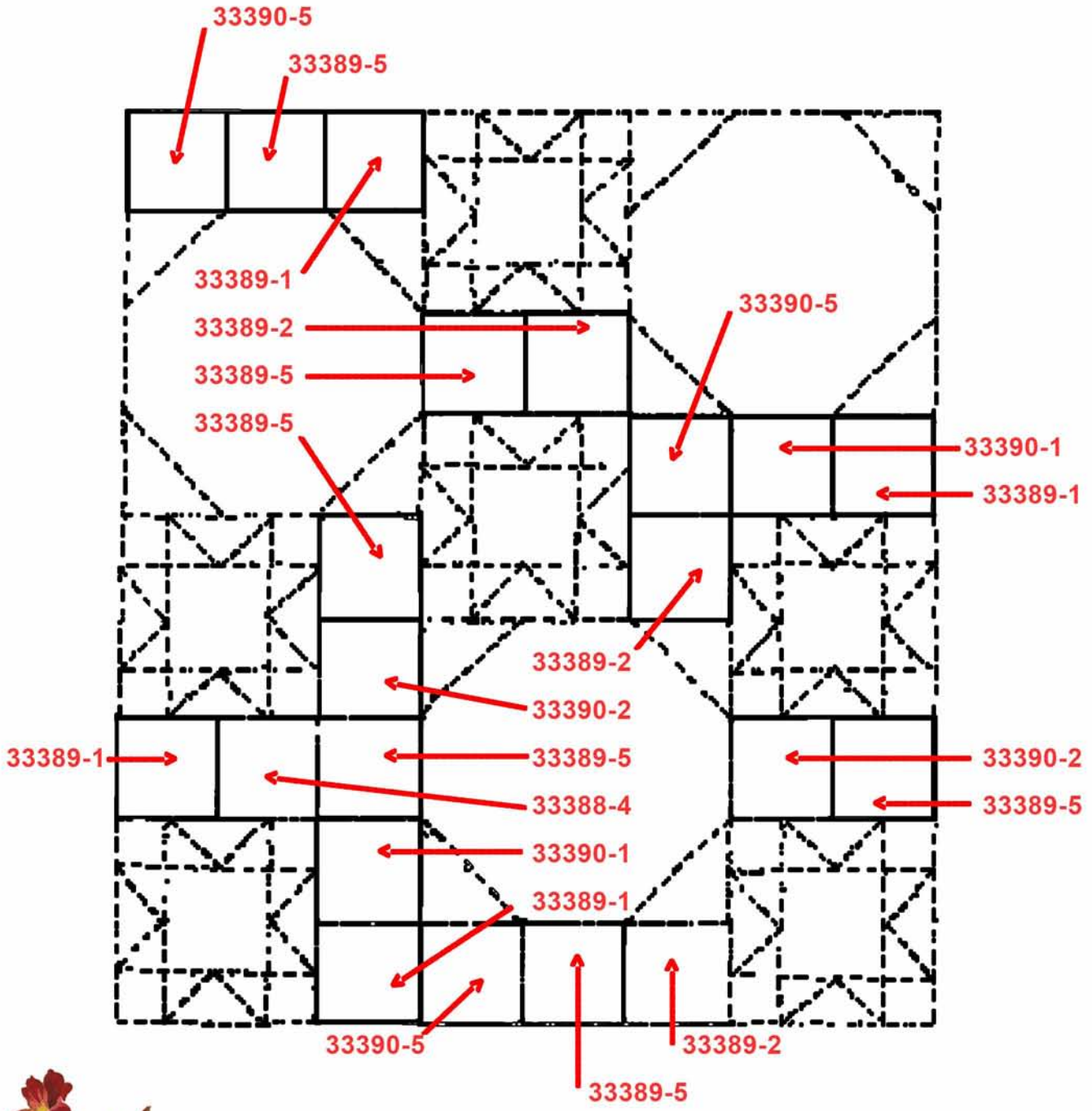
Follow picture of quilt as another guide to the fabric placements

Five-inch Background Designation



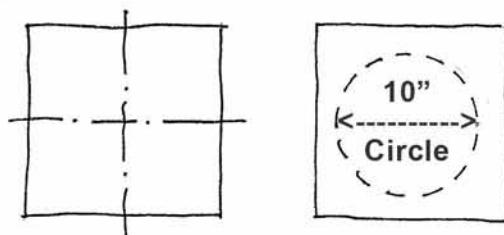

Block Assembly

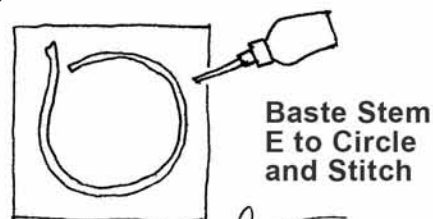
Prepare Background

- Cut 3 – 16” squares for background (to be trimmed to 15½” when appliqué is complete)
- Finger press into quarters
- Lightly mark a 10” circle on background – set aside.



Prepare bias for wreath stems and vine blocks

- Cut ½” wide bias strips
- Prepare ¼” finished bias tape (I use a ¼” clover™ bias tape maker)
- Roll onto a tube to keep it from tangling
- Using basting glue, baste bias to 10” marked circle on background block
- Appliqué in place using your favorite method.



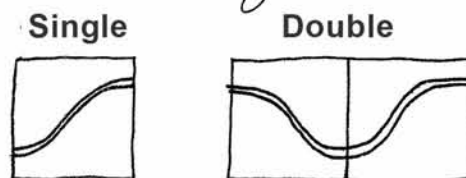
Prepare leaves for 15” blocks (finished)

- You will need 78 leaves for the three large blocks
- Prepare leaves for appliqué using your favorite technique
- Using the pattern as a guide, place leaves on background and appliqué in place.
- Repeat for all three blocks.



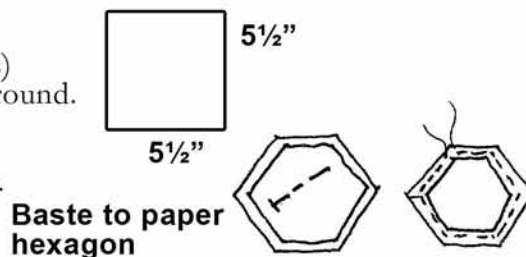
Prepare vine blocks

- Cut 12 – 5½” squares of assorted backgrounds – refer to background fabric guide for placement.
- Using pattern as a guide, assemble background squares for vine blocks
- Sew together in sets
 - 3 – single-block sets
 - 3 – two-block sets
 - 1 – three-block background set
- Using pattern as a guide, glue-baste vine to blocks
- Appliqué in place using your favorite method
- Following directions for wreath blocks and referring to pattern, prepare and appliqué leaves to vine blocks



Prepare flower blocks

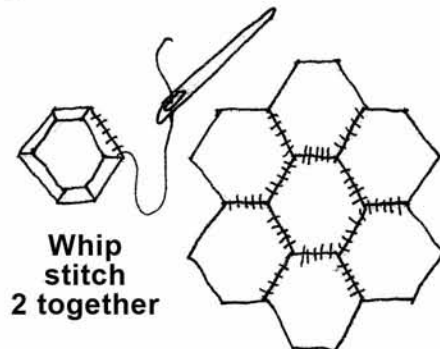
- Cut 9 – 5½” squares for blocks.
- Refer to background guide for fabric placement
- Cut 63 hexagons from freezer paper
- Cut 9 – 2½” squares of fabric for center hexagons (for flower centers)
- Pin paper shapes to fabric squares and trim to shape, leaving ¼” all around.
- Baste sides over onto paper
- Prepare the remaining hexagons as above for the flower petals
- Place two hexagons right side together and whipstitch along one edge.
- Open up and add another hexagon.
- Repeat to make a complete flower.
- Center hexagon flower on background square and appliqué in place.
- Repeat for remaining 8 flowers

Star blocks

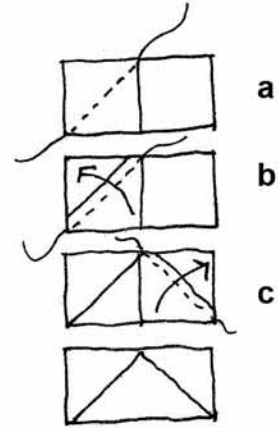
Instructions given for one star block – repeat to make 6 total

Refer to the fabric designations chart on Page 3 for placements

- For block background fabric, cut 4 – 3” squares and 4 – 3 x 5½” rectangles
- For star points, cut 8 – 3” squares
- For star center, cut 1 – 5½” square

To assemble star:

- Place 1 – 3” square star point on one end of 3 x 5½” rectangle. **(a)**
- Sew diagonally from outer corner to center. **(b)**
- Trim away star fabric at corner and fold back. **(c)**
- Repeat at other half of rectangle to make a flying geese block.
- Repeat above for a total of 4 flying geese blocks.
- Stitch together block segments as follows:



UNIT ONE

3” square/star point rectangle/3” square

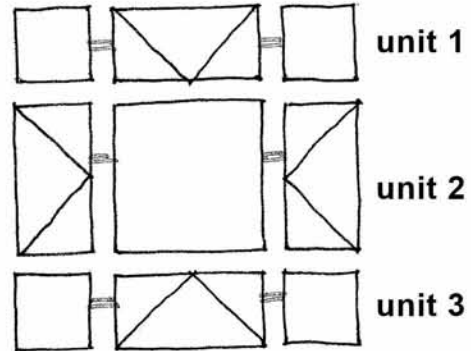
UNIT TWO

Star point rectangle/center square/star point rectangle

UNIT THREE

3” square/star point rectangle/3” square

- Stitch Unit One to Unit Two
- Stitch Unit Three to above to complete block
- Repeat above for remaining star blocks.



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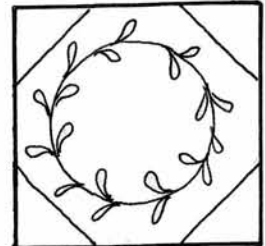

Unit Assembly

Unit A

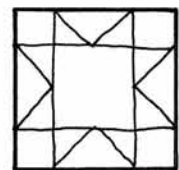
- Sew 2 section vine to flower block.
See diagram for vine orientation
- Sew one of above to one—15" square wreath block
- Set aside



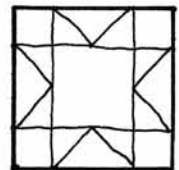
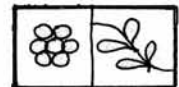

Unit B

- Sew one flower block to a one section vine. See diagram for vine orientation
- Sew one star block to top of above section and one star block to bottom
- Sew one flower block to each end of a three-section vine.
See diagram for block orientation.
- Sew long section to right side of double star section.
- Set aside

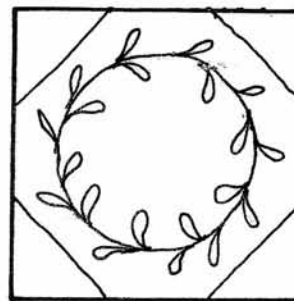
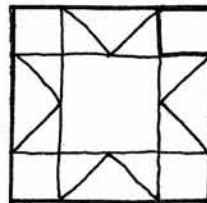

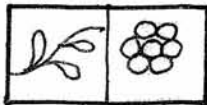


Unit C

- Sew a one section vine to flower block.
See block diagram for block orientation.
- Sew above to bottom of star block
- Sew above to 15" wreath block
- Set aside

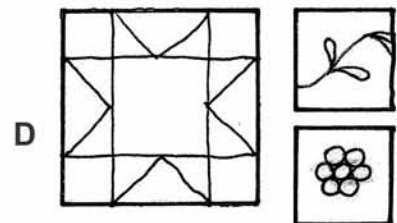

Unit D

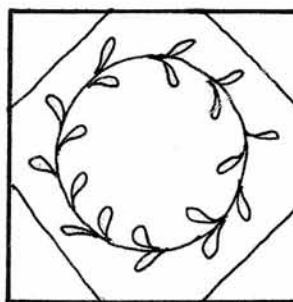
- Sew one section vine to flower block.
See diagram for vine orientation.
- Sew above to right side of star block
- Set aside.



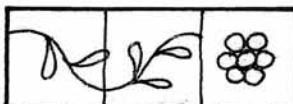

Unit E

- Sew two-section vine to flower block.
See diagram for vine orientation.
- Sew to bottom of 15" wreath block
- Set aside

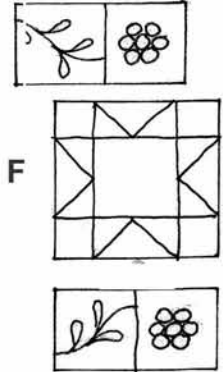

Unit F

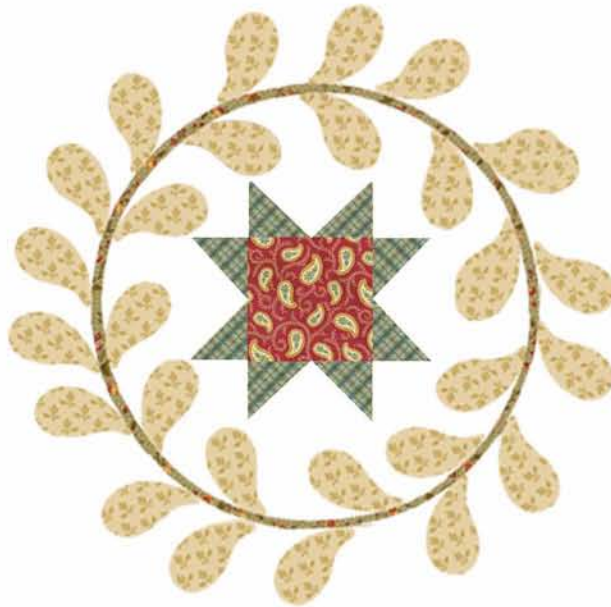
- Sew one-section vine block to one flower block.
See diagram for vine orientation
- Repeat above for a second section.
- Sew one-vine-flower unit to one star block. Repeat for second set.
- Sew both sets together with the vine-flower sections at top of each.
See diagram for orientation.



Final Assembly

- Sew Unit A to Unit B
- Sew Unit D to Unit E
- Sew Unit D/E to Unit F.
- Sew Unit D/E/F to Unit C
- Sew Unit A/B to Unit C/D/E/F
- Add 1" inner borders – sides first, then top and bottom.
- Add 5" borders – sides first, then top and bottom.

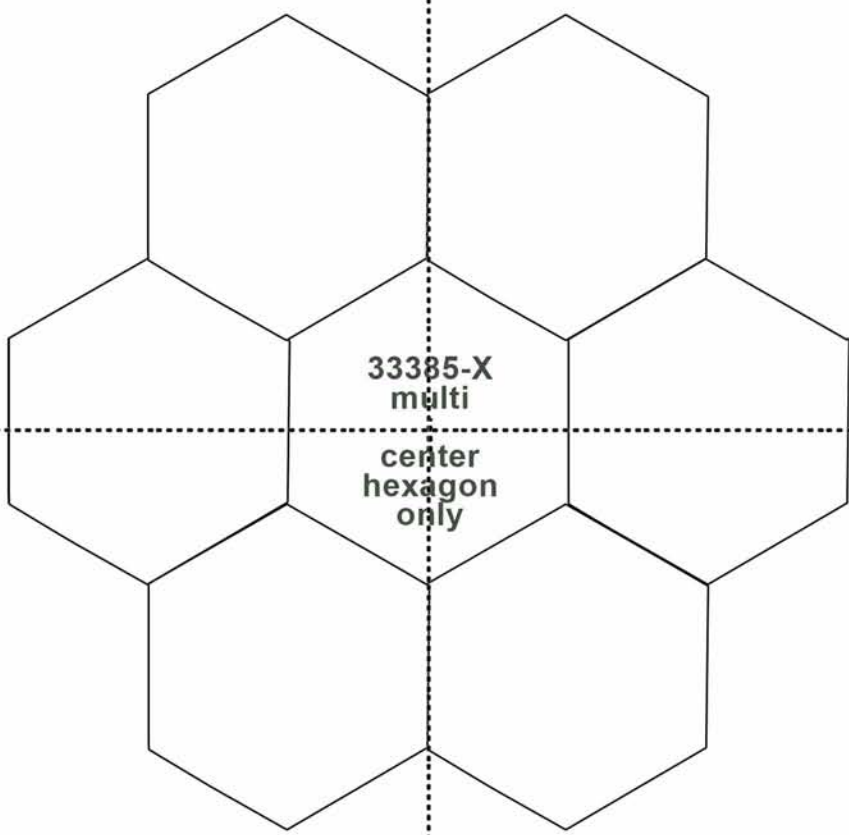


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Hexagon Flower Block

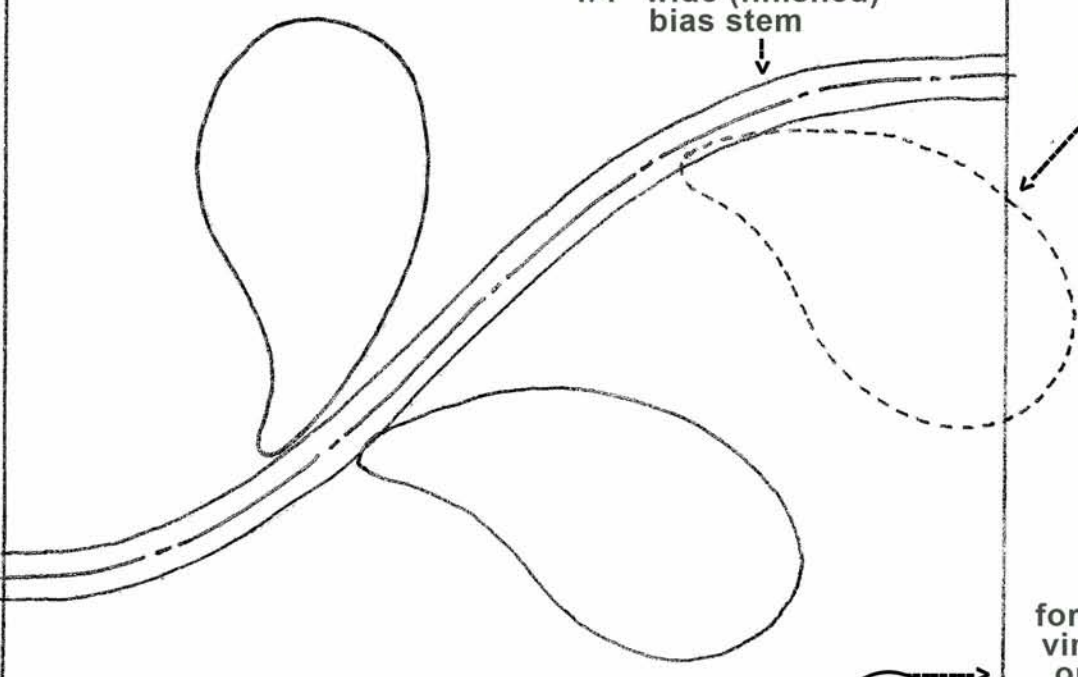
