Cutting the Fabric

Measurements include $\frac{3}{4}$ " seam allowances.
 All cuts are the width of the fabric unless otherwise indicated.

	1 1/8 yards	35155-4 Red	Sashing Checked Border	Cut 8 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips Cut 8 - 2" strips
	1/8 yard	35155-2 Green	Corner Squares	Cut 4 - 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares Cut 4 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
	1 yard	35156-6 Blue	Outer Border	Cut 8 - 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
	1/2 yard	35156-4 Red	Binding	Cut 7 - 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips
Panel	2 Panels	35152-X Multi	Center	Cut each picture 15" x 11 $\frac{1}{4}$ " leaving about 3/8" margins

Additional Material Needed:

- 66" x 84" Quilt Backing: 1 7/8 yards of wide backing or 3 3/4 yard of regular fabric
- 66" x 84" Quilt Batting

Making the Quilt

1. Cut 2 1/2" sashing strips into 10 - 15" pieces for top and bottom of panel pictures and 12 - 11 1/4" pieces for sides of panel pictures. Suggested cutting:

2. Sew 11 1/4" sashing pieces between picture as shown. Make two sets of each. Press.



3. Make five sashing strips with gold sashing squares and 15" red sashing pieces as shown.



Sew strips between picture panels matching seams to create the center panel.

4. Sew a 5" white border strip to top and bottom of quilt top. Press and trim even. Cut one strip in half and sew pieces to the two remaining strips to create the longer strips for sides. Sew, press and trim even.
5. Sew two narrow green strips together lengthwise. Then sew to each side of quilt. Press and trim even. Use the short remaining pieces from the sides and sew to the top and bottom strips for make them long enough. Make two border pieces 2 1/2" x 44 1/2". Sew the 2 1/2" square to each end. Sew to top and bottom of quilt top matching seams. Press.



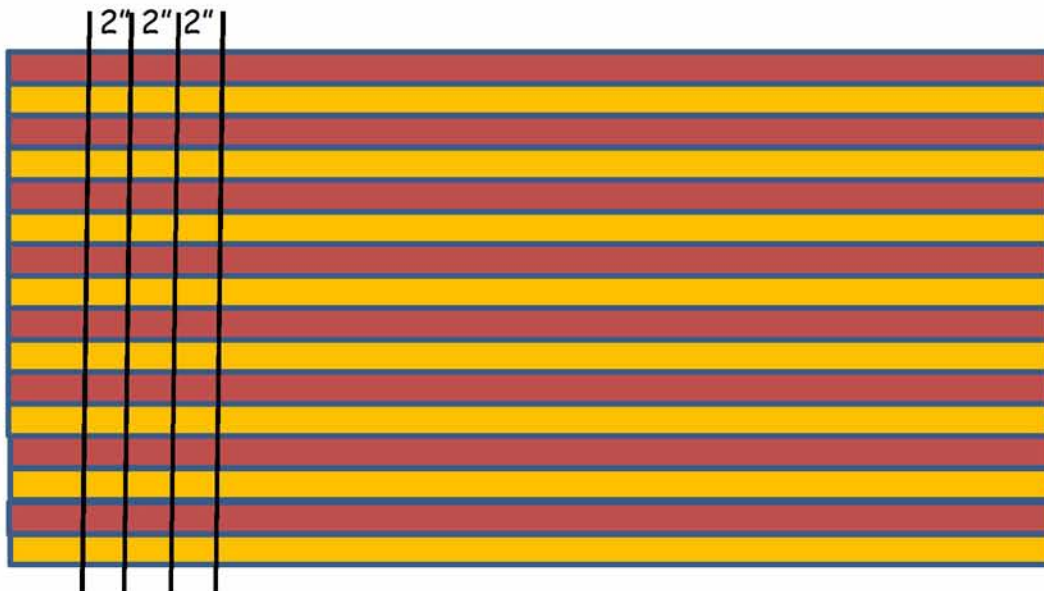

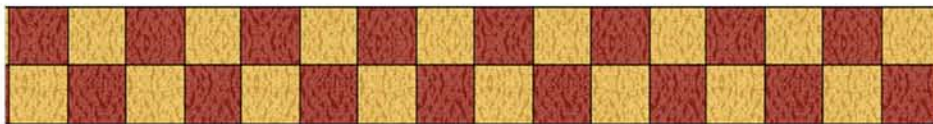

6. Sew the 8 red and 8 gold strips together alternating colors as follows. Press seams in one direction. Cut 20 - 2" strips.



7. Sew two strips together matching seams. Press. See illustration. Make 10 sets. Sew 3 sets together for each side and two sets together for the top and the bottom. Attach the side checkered strips. Remove extra squares. Sew a green $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " square to the ends of top and bottom strips before sewing them on.



8. Sew two blue strips together lengthwise for each side. Sew on side strips. Press and trim even. Sew on top and bottom blue borders. Press and trim even.

Finishing the Quilt

1. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Use temporary fabric spray adhesive or pin for basting. Quilt as desired.
2. Join $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " wide strips into 1 continuous piece for binding. Fold lengthwise and press. Trim and square quilt. Sew binding to quilt with a quarter inch seam. Either hand stitch in place; or turn, press, and machine stitch in the ditch.



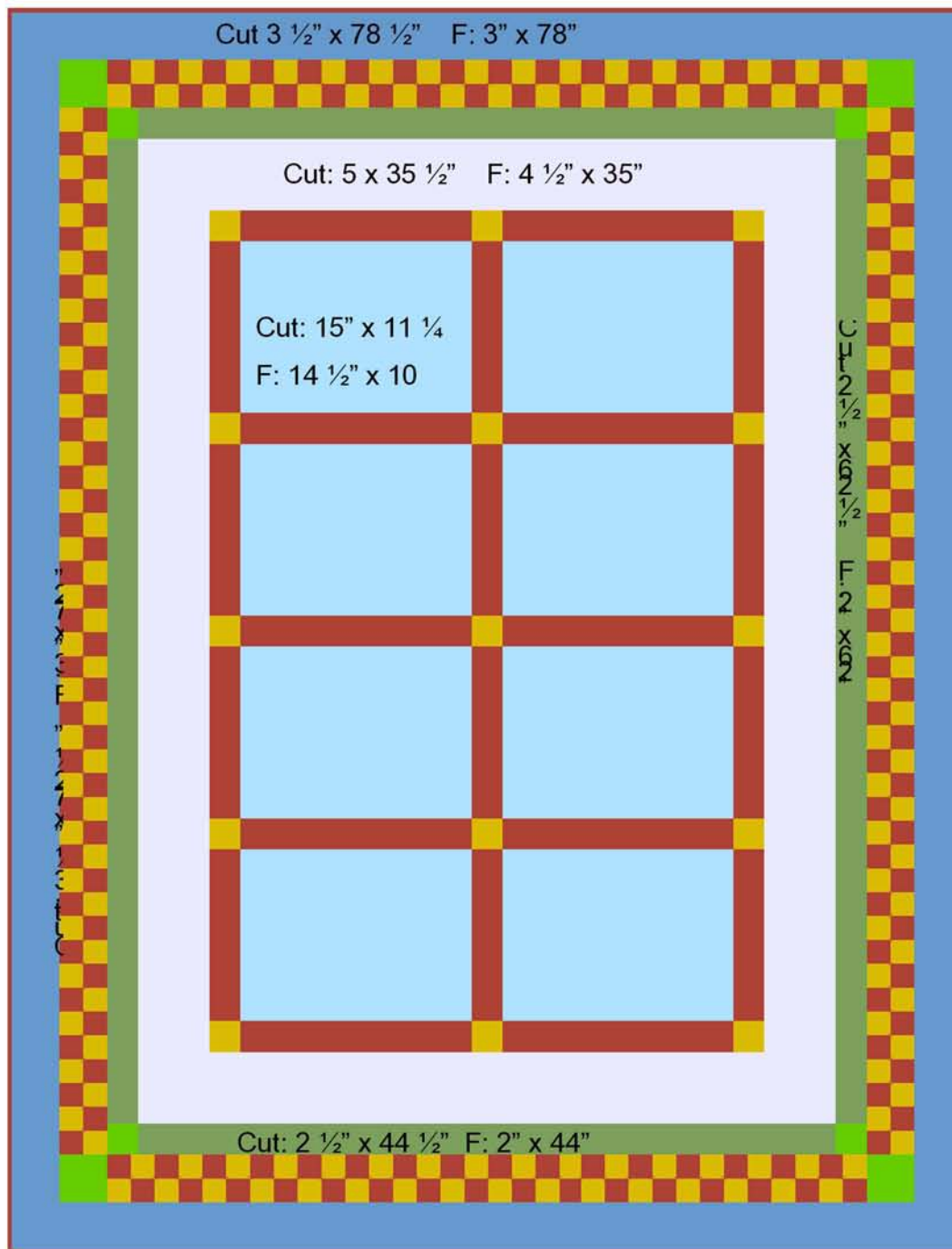
