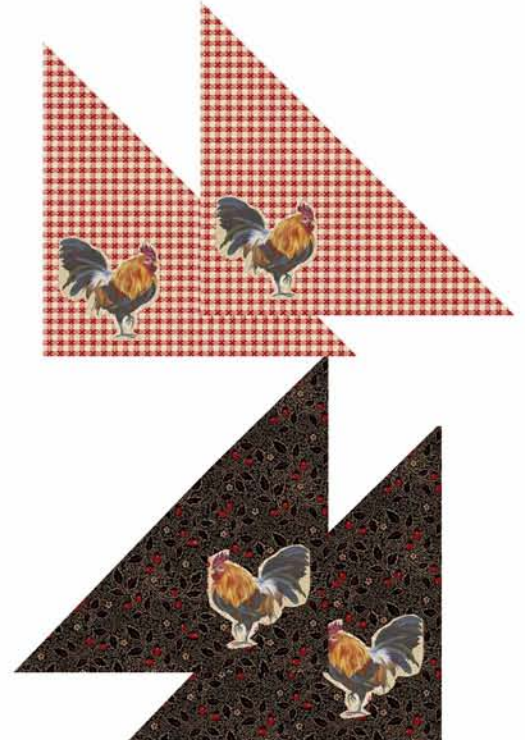
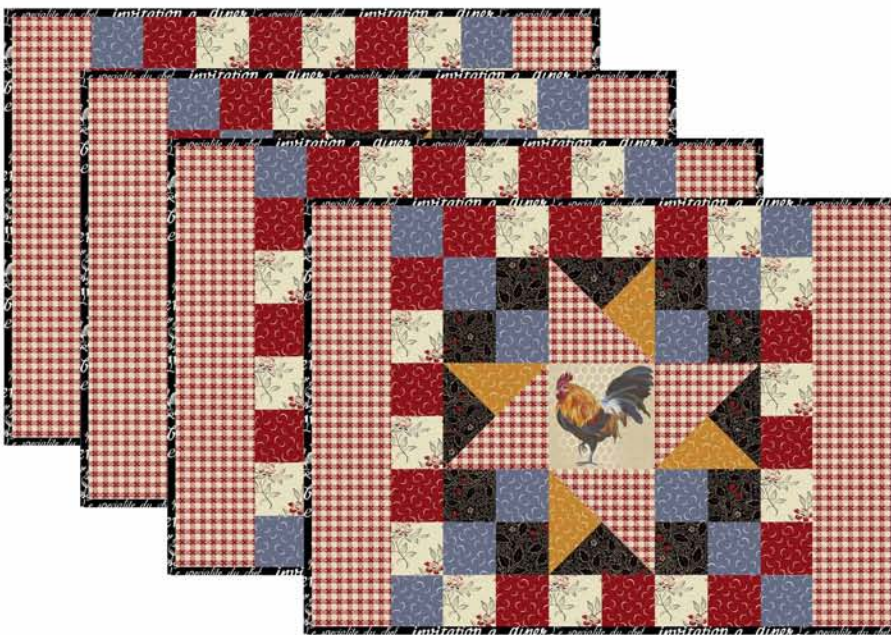



### Table Runner and Napkins

Estimates for yardage assume long border strips are pieced. Additional fabric needed for strips cut on the lengthwise grain. All strips are cut across the with of the fabric unless noted (\*) otherwise.

Seam allowances of 1/4" are included in all measurements.

	2/3 yard	35431-X Multi	Center Blocks	*Fussy cut 4 - 10 1/2" x 12 1/2" blocks.
	1/8 yard	35437-6 Blue	Small Corner Posts Larger Corner Posts	Cut 1-1 1/2" strip. Recut into 4 squares. Cut 1-2 1/2" strip. Recut into 4 squares.
	1/3 yard	35433-1 Black	Binding	Cut 4-2 1/2" strips.
	1/4 yard	35437-5 Red	Checkerboard Sashing	Cut 2-1 1/2" strips. Recut into 52 squares.
	3/4 yard	35436- Red	Checkerboard Sashing Outside Border	Cut 2-1 1/2" strips. Recut into 52 squares. Cut 4 2 1/2" strips.
	1 1/2 yard	Your Favorite	Backing	Cut larger than top.
	1/2 yard	35436-5 Red	2 Napkins	Cut 2-18" squares.
	1/2 yard	35435-1 Black	2 Napkins	Cut 2-18" squares.
	1/4 yard	35432-2 Tan		Cut out 4 chickens.

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## Assembly Directions

### Table Runner

1. Sew the four large chicken blocks side by side.
2. Join the red checked squares and the red printed squares to make the first border. Use the small blue squares as corner posts at the corners.
3. Measure the width of the top cut the 2 ½" checked fabric to that length and attach to the sides of the top.
4. Measure the length of the top, subtract 9" and add the 2 ½" blue corner posts, sew this segment to the top. Repeat for the other side.
5. Trim your chosen backing fabric to about 4" larger on all sides than your top.
6. Sandwich the top, batting and backing and quilt as desired.
7. Using the 2 ½" black printed strips bind by hand or machine.

### Napkins

8. Napkins: Take the 18" napkin square and using fusible webbing cut out a chicken for one corner of the napkins. Finish the napkin edges as you like.

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### Placemat

All strips are cut across the width of the fabric unless noted (\*) otherwise. Seam allowances of 1/4" are included in all measurements.

	1/8 yard	35432-2 Tan	Center Square	* Fussy cut one 3 7/8" square.
	1/8 yard	35437-6 Blue	Corner Four Patches	Cut 1- 2 1/8" strip. Recut into 12 squares
	1/8 yard	35437-4 Gold	Star Points	Cut one 4 1/2" square. Recut diagonally twice.
	1/8 yard	35437-5 Red	Checkerboard Border	Cut one 2 1/8" strip. Recut into 12 squares.
	1/8 yard	35434-5 Red	Checkerboard Border	Cut one 2 1/8" strip. Recut into 12 squares.
	1/4 yard	35433-1 Black	Binding	Cut 2-2 1/2" strips.
	1/4 yard	35435-1 Black	Corner Four Patches  Star Background Triangles	Cut 1-2 1/8" strip. Recut into 8 squares.  Cut one 4 1/2" square. Recut diagonally twice.
	1/4 yard	35436-5 Red	Star Points  Side Borders	Cut two 4 1/8" squares. Recut diagonally once.  Cut one 3" strip. Recut into two rectangles 13 3/4".
	1 1/4 yards	Favorite Fabric	Backing	





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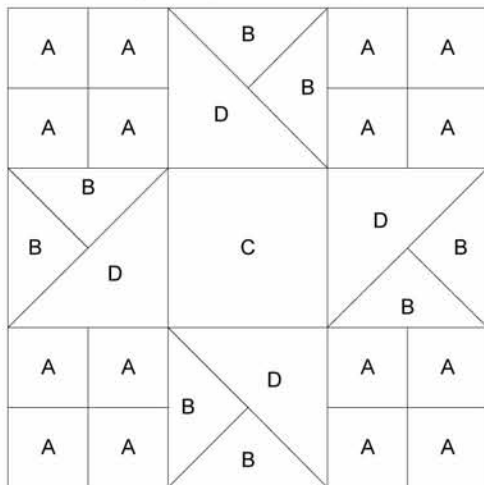
## Table Runner and Placemats

### Assembly

1. Key Lime Pie Star-(10" finished block) gather the pieces for the 4 stars. You will need: 16 large red check triangles, 16 gold small triangles, 16 black small triangles and 32 black squares and 32 blue squares, and 4 fussy cut chicken squares.

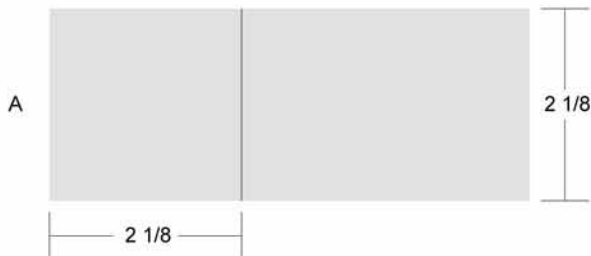
### Key Lime Pie

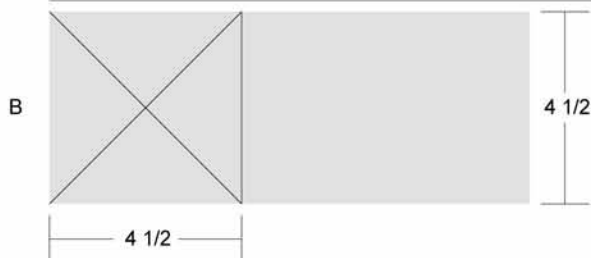

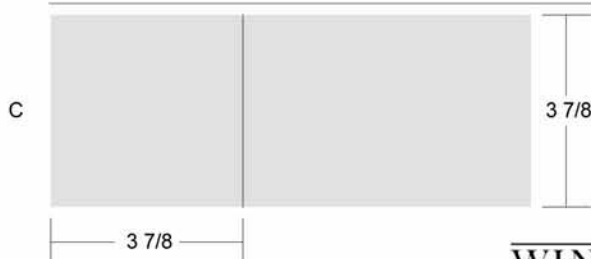

2. Make the 16 star unit segments first. Join the small black and the small gold triangles, iron seams open. Trim 'ears'. Sew those to the red check triangle.
3. Make the 16 four patch segments. Sew the black and blue squares in pairs, then join the pairs to make the four patches.
4. Assemble the star segments and four patches around the fussy cut chicken square.
5. Add the strips of squares surrounding the star block.
6. Now to the right and left sides of the placemat top sew the 3" red checked strips, trimming to fit where necessary.
7. Finishing: I like to use cotton batting. Sandwich the backing, batting and top, spray fusible is fun to use on small projects like place mats and table runners. I stitched in the ditch around the center patchwork star and squares, added a few vertical parallel rows of stitching in the red checked wide side bars. Bind your preferred way.
