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Because of the different widths of the zigzags this quilt is not made in the traditional triangle method. Instead fabric strips are sew together to make strip sets. The strips from these are cut at 45°. Directions are for two quilt sizes. Smaller quilt highlighted. Fabric is cut the width of the fabric unless otherwise indicated. Please note that one fabric is cut lengthwise following the stripe.

Additional Material Needed:

For 56" x 60" Quilt

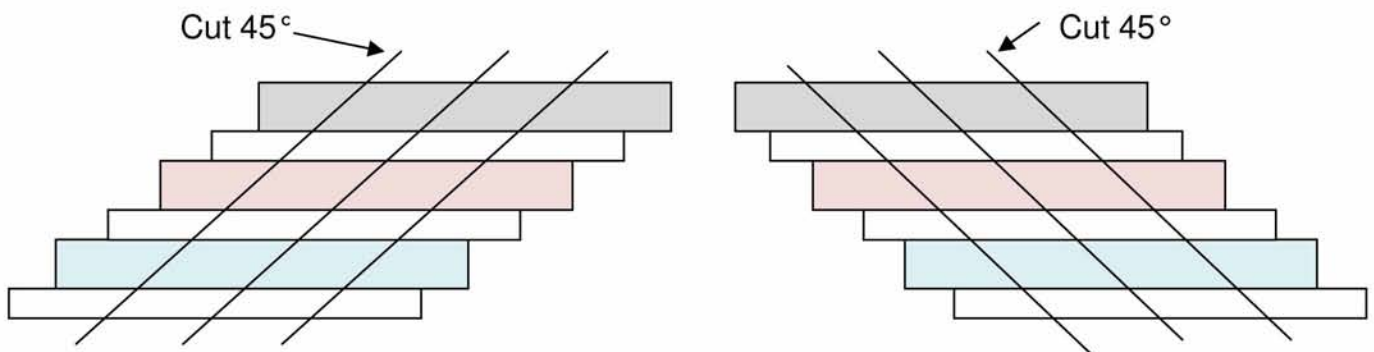
- 62" x 66" Backing Fabric
- 62" x 66" Quilt Batting

For 80" x 84" Quilt

- 86" x 90" Backing Fabric
- 86" x 90" Quilt Batting

Making the Quilt

1. Using the quilt picture for fabric placement, sew the first 6 fabric strips together staggering them about 3 inches. Make 2 going this way. Sew the remaining 6 strips together offset in the opposite direction. Make 2.
2. Do the same for the next 5 strips making 2 sets in each direction.
3. Press and starch. Press white strip seams out.



4. Cut 2 - 45° strips from each set following the angle of the offset rows.

Cut the strips for the smaller quilt 7 ½".

Cut the strips for the larger quilt 10 ½"

(To make the angle cut, line up the 45° line on the ruler with the top edge of the fabric strip.)

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5. Sew the top strips and bottom strips together to form long strip. Press white seams toward printed fabrics.
6. Matching seams sew strips together to create the zigzags. Use white thread.
7. Trim top and bottom even.
8. Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Bind with pink fabric strips.
